Learn about 2025-2027 grant funding eligible toward public improvements to facilities, affordable housing, and/or public service projects within the Westchester Urban County Consortium\*. The County Department of Planning administers CDBG funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This info session will discuss the next 3-year application cycle, including the submission of up to four projects totaling a maximum cap of \$1M in requests for review by the County.

### Location



Directions to Greenburgh Town Hall

177 Hillside Avenue, White Plains (Greenburgh), NY 10603

Going west on Tarrytown Road (toward White Plains) Hillside Avenue is at the fourth traffic light after the Library. Turn left onto Hillside and at second traffic light, turn right into Town Hall parking lot.

From Bronx River Parkway north or south: Take County Center exit. Turn right immediately onto Tarrytown Road (west - away from White Plains). Go past Greenburgh Police Station to 3rd traffic light, Hillside Avenue. Turn right onto Hillside and at second traffic light, turn right into Town Hall parking lot.

Going west on the Cross Westchester/287 take exit 5. Turn right at the exit light. Go to next traffic light and turn right into Town Hall parking lot.

Going east on Cross Westchester /287 take exit 4, make left at exit light and go to light at Old Tarrytown Road. Turn right. At end of road, continue straight thru traffic light into Town Hall parking lot.
